Dear Graduates,

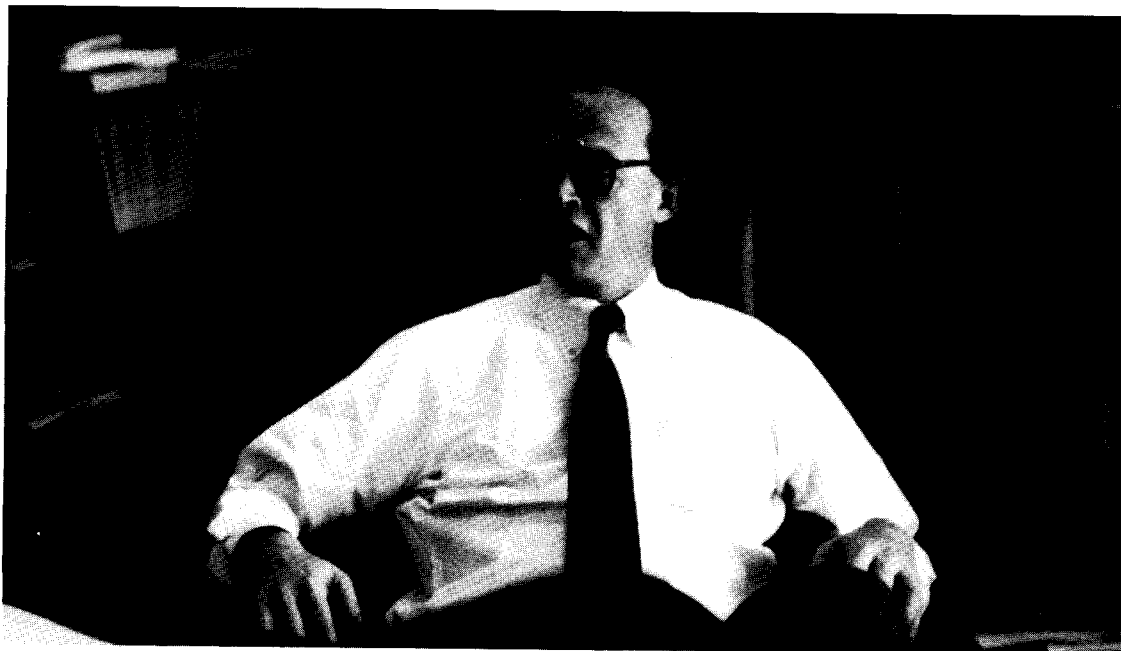

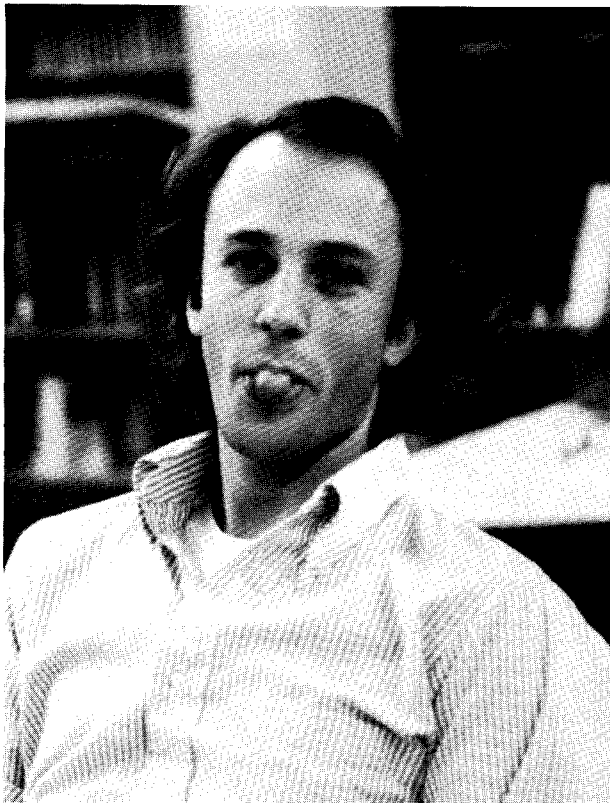
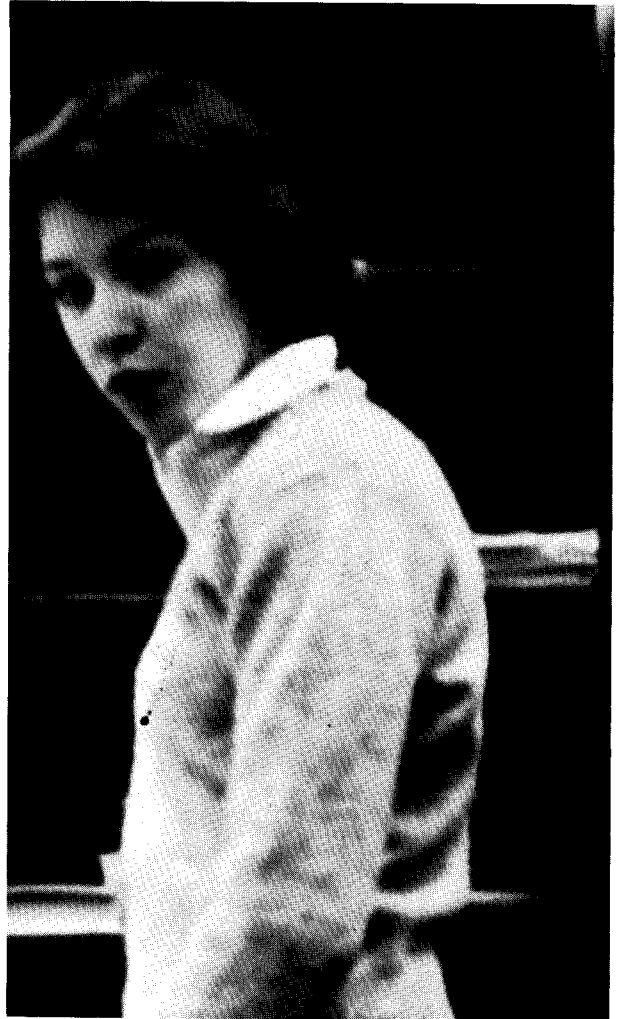


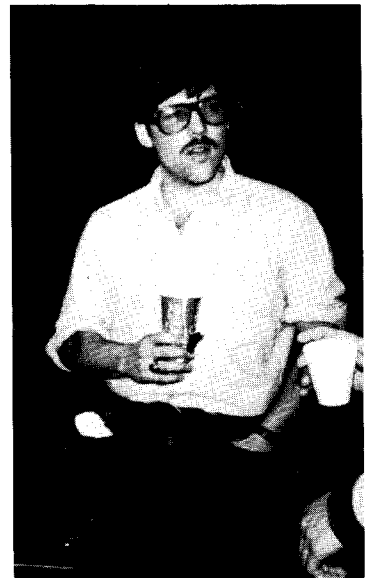


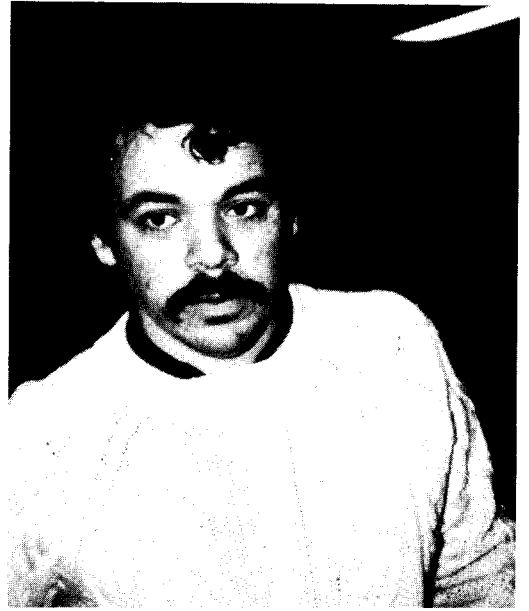


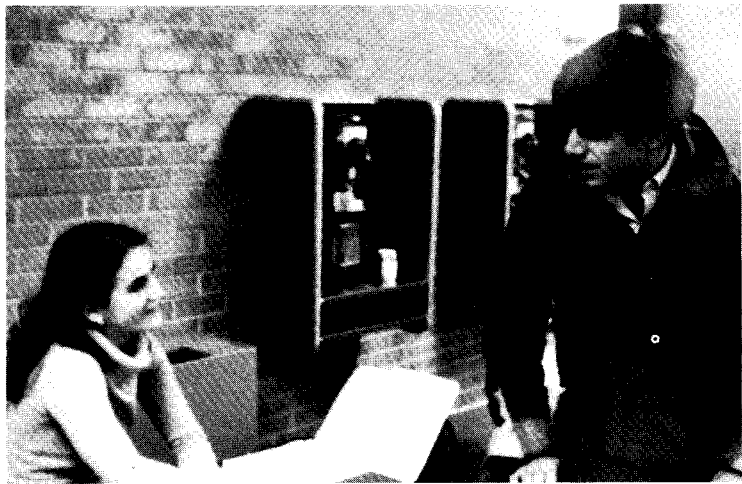


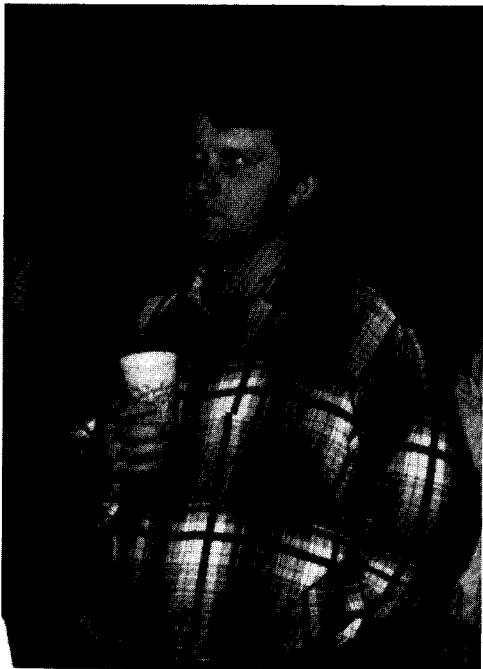


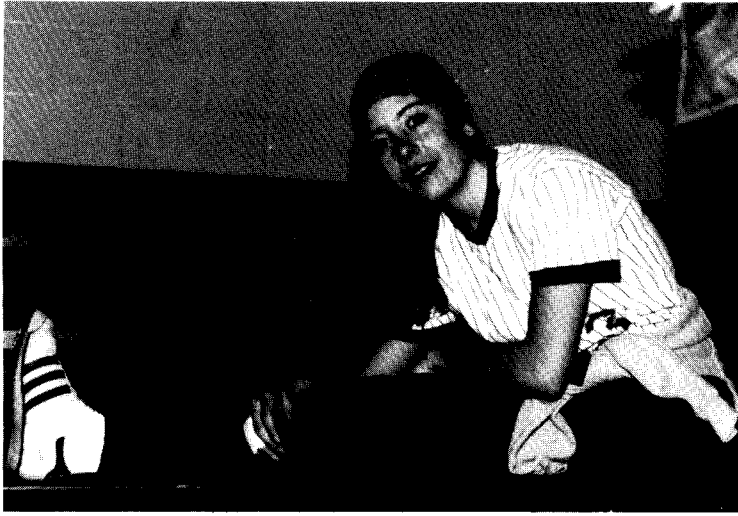






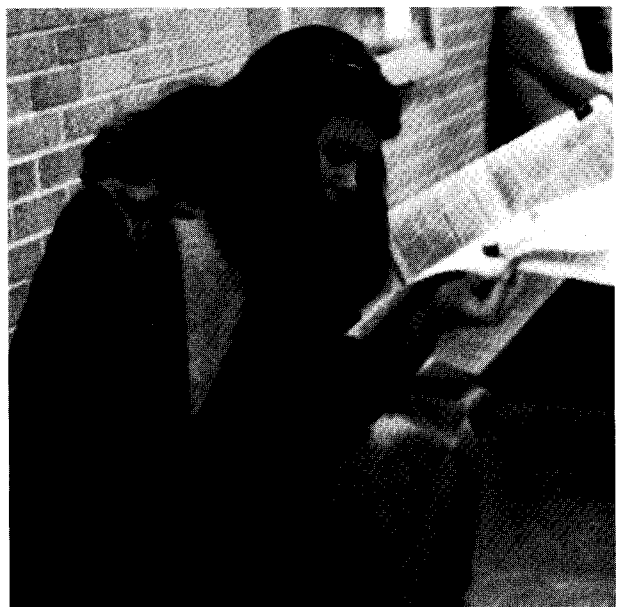
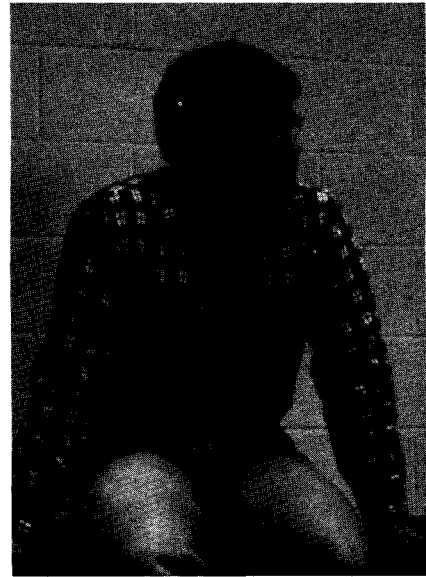




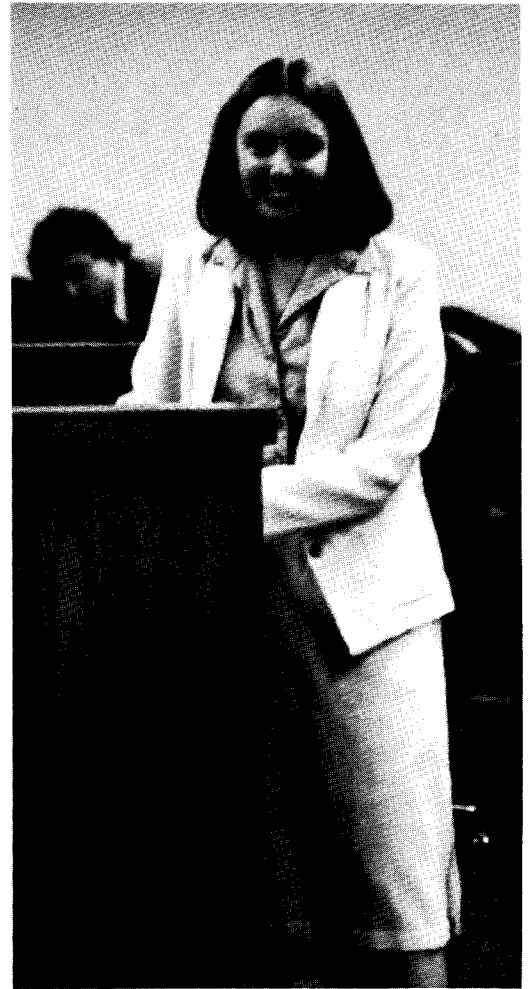
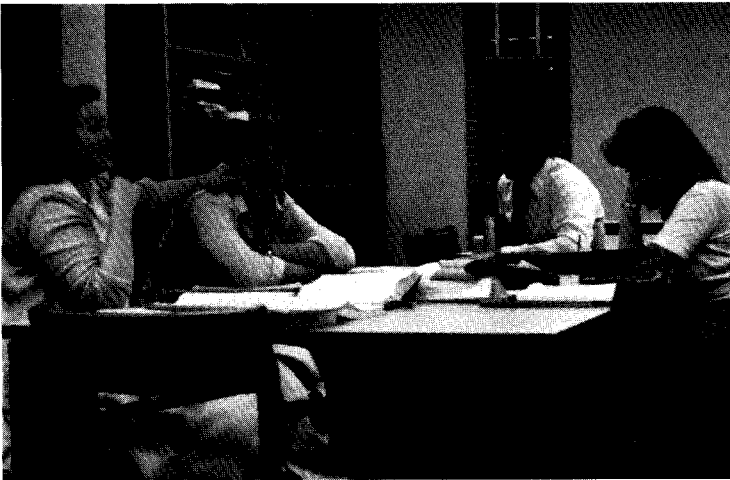




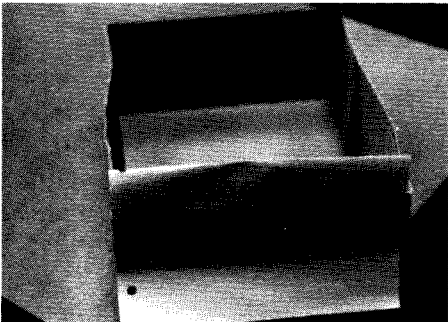


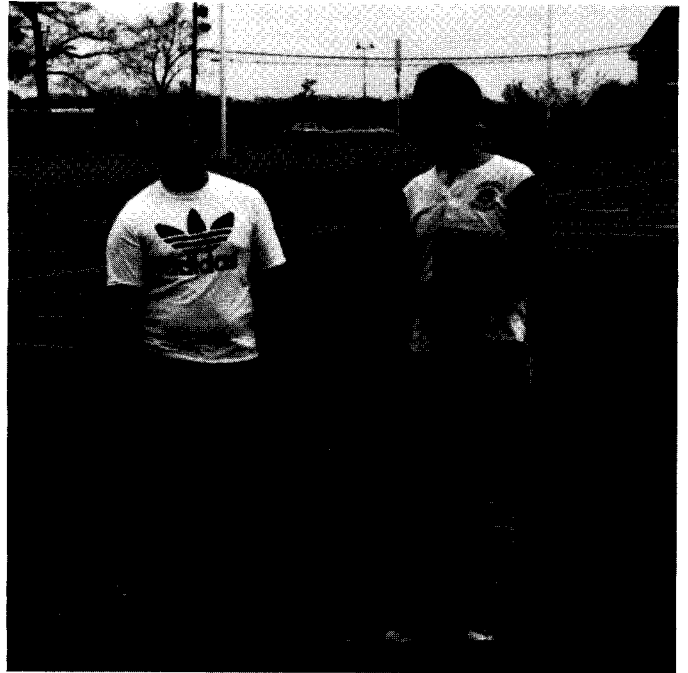
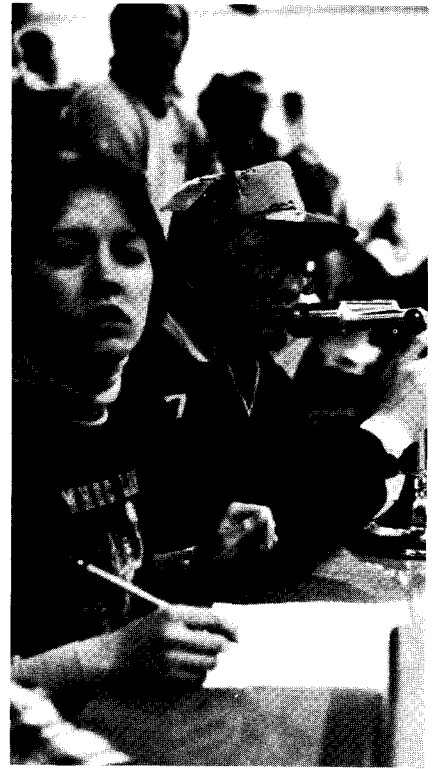
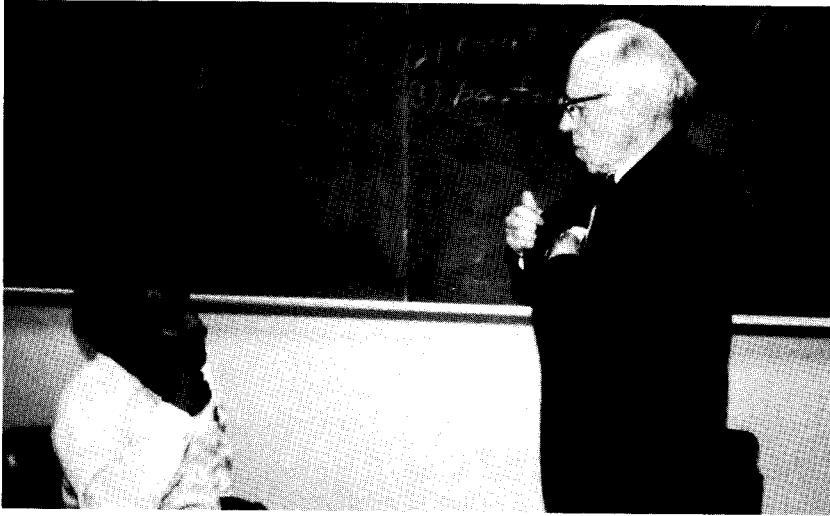


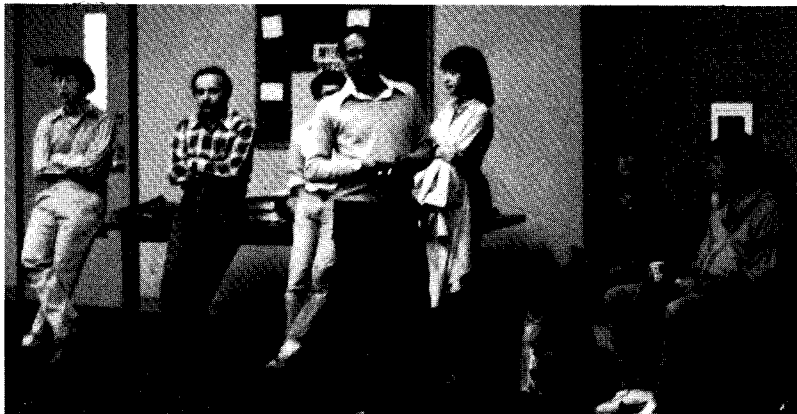
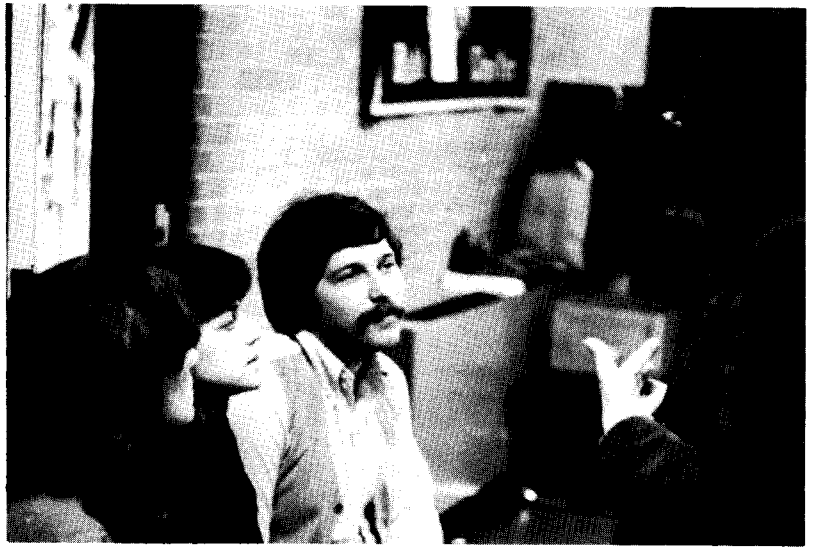
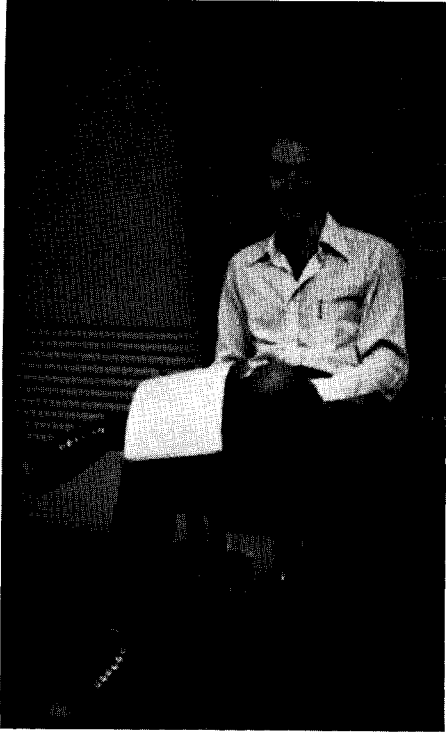












Tw'as the night before last

Of the end-year blues

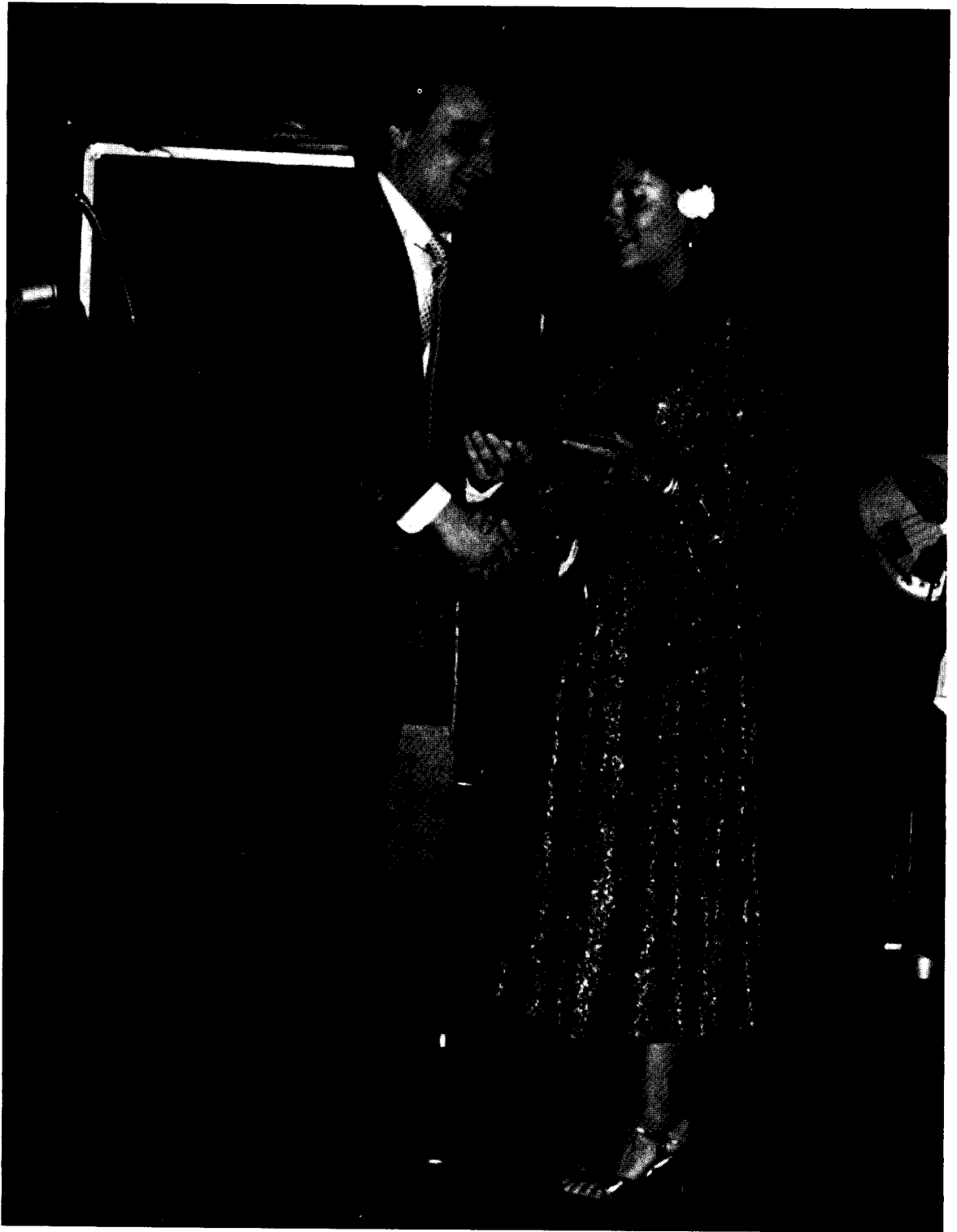
